


The STEAM Connection is designing a low-cost 3D-printed educational robot made from durable plastic-free biodegradable materials.

Application Components

Electronic Verifications of Support

- Faculty Advisor/Principal Investigator
- Administrative Contact



Office of Sponsored Programs/Research

- VentureWell grant funds are awarded to your university, not to your team or PI, so you must get approval and support from the Office of Sponsored Programs/Research (OSP).
- The **OSP assists faculty and students** in the review, approval and submission of a grant proposal (pre-award) and the negotiation, acceptance and administration of a grant (post-award).
- You will likely need to send your **full proposal to the OSP office 6-10 weeks in advance** of the deadline to verify that they support your proposal. Sometimes, the OSP office will want to submit the proposal on your behalf.
- You'll need to identify an **Administrative Contact** at your OSP who can verify support. Your university website should have a page for your Office of Sponsored Programs/Research with a staff list with contact information.



Administrative Contact (AC)

- The AC is the person in the OSP who can sign the award agreement and bind the university to the terms of the grant.
- The AC will verify support of your proposal via our online proposal tool.
- You will also work with a pre-award person in the office to review your proposal, as well as a post-award person who will help you set up the funds disbursement process if you are funded.
- They will also be able to explain your university's process for accessing the funds.



Faculty Advisor/Principal Investigator (PI)

- Faculty or staff person who is willing to support your team during the grant and help you navigate university processes.
- The PI is responsible for tracking, overseeing, and reporting on the disbursement of grant funds.
- Let your PI know they'll be receiving the automated email to verify support of your project.



Submitting your application

Submit all components through **CGI U's online portal**. Proposals are *not* accepted via email.

HOW TO APPLY

Prospective applicants are encouraged to:

- Read the Prompt and Rubric to narrow down your project focus area
- Form teams of 2-3 with complementary skill sets and experience
- Attend at least one information session
- Submit application by January 21, 2022

The project submission deadline is Friday, January 21, 2022. Applications will be Committee, and all applicants will be notified of their application status in April 2022

by the Challenge Selection



If Your Team is Funded

Accessing the Funds

Speak to your AC or PI about your university's specific process

How it often works:

- A post-award individual is assigned to oversee the grant.
- A financial account is created with an accounting code against which you will submit invoices or reimbursement requests often to your post-award contact or finance office.

Your PI is ultimately responsible for tracking, overseeing, and reporting on the disbursement of grant funds.

VentureWell does not allow any grant funds to be used for overhead/facilities and administrative (F&A) costs.
